Just following on from last night's email.

If you need to send your children to school next week because your work commitments have changed, just let me know.

Postgate School will be open next week for students who cannot continue with Distance Learning. We currently have four teachers at school and will increase this if needs be. If we were to change Alert Levels on Monday, we know more of our family members could be returning to work come Wednesday.

If the announcement is to change Alert Levels on Monday **and if** we are to return to school the following Monday, there will be no Distance Learning on Thursday 14th and Friday 15th.

Postgate School will still be open on Thursday and Friday for children who require supervision. If this applies to your child, please let me know. We will need to book relievers to cater for the children who may return, no stress.

I will send you a confirmed timetable for next week following Monday's announcement.

We know children, and staff, are keen and eager to get back into school and some semblance of our normal routines. The key for us is to reopen with our Health and Safety plans well in place and ensuring we are back into learning come on this first day back at school. We received an email from the Ministry of Education last night about returning to school and how schools will operate. We are working through this document today and in my opinion, it pretty reasonable for schools to effectively operate under.
