We trust you are well and have taken a couple of deep breathes and continued on with your day. We understand that anxiety levels in some families may have risen and we want to remind you what Alert Level 2 looks like at Postgate School

- If your child is unwell, please keep them at home. If they have a fever, are coughing or if they have a runny nose, please take them to your local GP and get tested
- Children should not be at school before 8:30am and need to enter through our school gates and are asked to avoid the office area
- Parents/caregivers need to 'kiss and drop' at the gate. Under Alert Level 2 only parents/caregivers of Year 1 pupils may enter the school grounds. This is before and after school.
- If you do enter a building, you must sign the Contact Register or scan the QR code at the office
- As a school, we can not have mass gatherings. So, no physical assembly on Friday; we will be online!
- Sports still continue. At this stage, gatherings must be under 100
- Staff are ensuring children wash/sanitize their hands before they enter the classroom and before they eat as well as when they leave the classroom
- Staff are also ensuring children are wiping down desks etc regularly during the day
- And, the focus stays on our learning in the classroom

At this stage, we are at Alert Level 2 until Friday, after that, we wait to be told. Please rest assured we place the safety of your children, our staff, and our community as our top priority at these uncertain times.
