**Important aspects of the Learning Conversation to remember**

- The conversation is about learning —not behaviour or social issues. (If you or the teacher have concerns here, another time will need to be made for these - ideally, they have already happened)
- If English is not your first language, your child is welcome to use their native language so that you are both more confident and comfortable.
- Your child will run this conversation—not the teacher! Your child must be here.
- As part of their regular learning, our students have become excited about sharing their learning. If you cannot attend, please arrange another significant adult in your child’s life to come to the conversation.
- Please arrange alternative care for siblings so that each child gets your full focus.
- This conversation is about your child’s learning and their progress. Please be mindful of comparing or commenting on another children’s work. We are all on our own journey.
