We were running the cultural concert with a zero budget. 960 tickets were issued, including free tickets; however, I didn't see many spare seats. 1,300 seats were available.

The total cost for the Arena, lights and sound was \$6,300. This is at a discounted price as we follow the College Sports Awards, which were on the night before.

There were some other costs (extra costumes, materials, 'ei katu, additional hours to Support Staff) which came to approximately \$2k.

So, we do have money left over and Mr Whippy will be booked to celebrate our awesome concert, as long as students continue to show Postgate PRIDE. (Approx. \$1600) We will let you know when Mr Whippy is coming and we will also sort something for those people who have special dietary requirements.

With all these costs, we will break about even.
